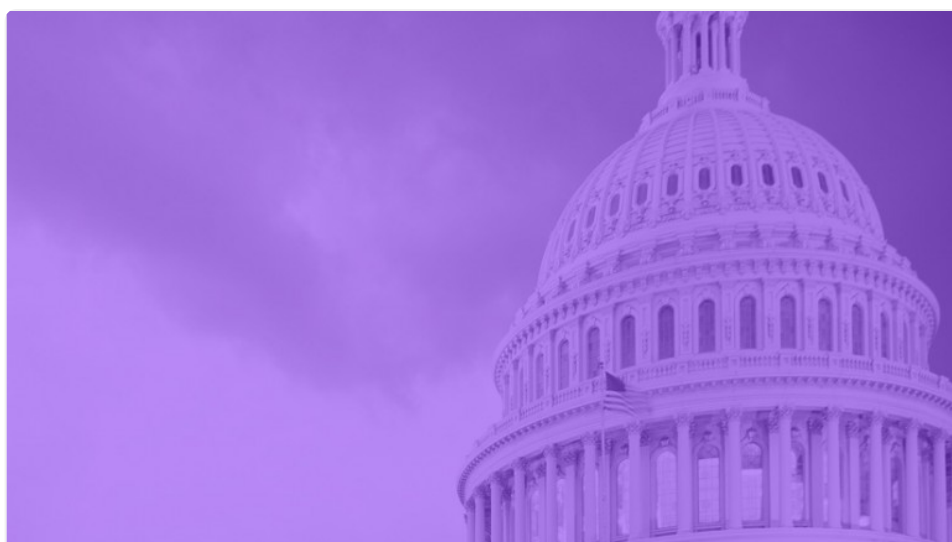




Music Modernization Act Signed Into Law
